

WAVE WEEK RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Delegates must remain within the "Triangle of Power" while at *WW*. Remember, we're responsible for your safety.
2. If you drove a car to *WW*, the keys are to be left in the *WW* office, where they will be kept safe and returned to you at the end of the week.
3. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted. ***Violators of this rule will immediately be sent home, and the proper authorities will be notified.***
 - If you have any legal medications (prescription), please leave them with the nurse and they will be administered as needed.
4. Weapons of any kind (guns, knives, brass knuckles, etc...) are not permitted at *WW*. ***Violators of this rule will immediately be sent home, and the proper authorities will be notified.***
5. Smoking is not permitted by anyone while at *WW*. ***Violators of this rule will be sent home.***
6. Gambling (for money, candy, or anything else) is not permitted. ***Violators of this rule will be sent home.***
7. ***Meals*** (yes, including breakfast) ***are not an option*** - even if you don't want to eat.
 - Shirts, shorts and shoes are required.
 - You cannot leave the meal until announcements are made (about halfway through the time period).
 - Also, the maid is taking off the week of *WW* so please return your tray to the dish-washing area and clean up any mess on your table.
8. Attendance at all classes, meetings, and events are ***mandatory***. We'll worry sick, so please be on time.
9. Delegates are ***not allowed to have outside visitors*** during *WW* (including the pizza man, etc.). At last count, *WW* was only 6 days and that left 359 days for everyone else. You will still have contact with the outside world (see rules 10 and 11).
10. If you have a letter to mail, seek out one of the staff members. We're so nice that we'll save you the walk and we'll mail the letter for you. Do not leave the "Triangle of Power" to mail anything.
11. Cell phones are a great way to keep in touch with others. However, they can also be a distraction to those around you. Cell phones may be used during free time, but must remain turned off when not at the dorm and cannot be used after "lights-out" or before breakfast. ***If these items are used inappropriately (i.e. going off in class, etc.), they will be taken and returned to you at the end of WW.***
12. All delegates must be in their rooms by 11:00 PM. Remember, when you are in your room after 11, ***you are there for the night***. Quiet and peace should prevail by 11:30 - the same time your lights need to be out. The security chairperson does make rounds and knows what you're up to.
13. We don't like litter. Neither does the school, nor Mother Earth for that matter. If you have any trash, throw it in a trash can (hence, the name☺). Also, please recycle when appropriate.
14. We recommend that you don't bring valuables to *WW*. STW is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
 - You should always lock your room when going to a class, meeting or event.
15. Name tags must be worn on the upper left, front part of your shirt so that it is ***visible*** at all times
 - This includes meals, classes, meetings, free time, etc... This rule is only bendable while at the dance or while participating in the talent show.
16. ***No*** male delegates are allowed in the female wings of the dorm, and ***No*** females are allowed in the male wings of the dorm. ***This is strictly enforced!***
 - The only exception to this rule is if your color group meets in an "off-limits" area.
17. Please wear shoes or sandals at all times. You don't want a cut foot any more than we do.
18. ***Do unto others as you would have them do unto you!***
19. ***Have as much fun as humanly possible, but let's keep each other safe.***
